Notes

Number on roll at Upton is a forecast. It assumes that the school roll will not grow significantly between now and July 2006.

Ellacombe would admit up to 97 pupils in September 2006. Roll rises from 249 to 346. School Capacity is 420.

St Margarets would admit up to 69 pupils in September 2006. Roll rises from 302 to 371. School Capacity is 420.

The additional classes created at Ellacombe and St Margarets would be additional classes i.e. over and above the school's normal Planned Admission Number.

Other schools also have spaces which extends the scope for parental preference across all year groups, including Years Four and Five. Parents will have a wider choice of schools than Ellacombe and St Margarets. The above plan is simply to indicate that there is a sufficiency of places to decant pupils.
