Sex & Relationships Education

Youth workers provide short courses, workshops and individual advice and support to young people in youth and school settings. In some settings access to contraception and/or pregnancy testing may be available.

Lesbian, Gay, Bi-sexual, Trans and Questioning (LGBTQ)

Kushbai is a group of Torbay LGBTQ (Lesbian, Gay, Bi-sexual, Trans and Questioning) young people who meet up to discuss issues. The group provides activities and a place where young LGBTQ people can meet and socialise.

Drugs and Alcohol Information

Youth workers can provide support, information and advice for young people on a one2one or group basis.

Positive Activities for Young People (PAYP)
