**371. Urgent items**

The Working Party received a verbal update from David Blanchard on the recent inspection which took place and explained that for health and safety, the decision was taken to close the Café immediately.

**372. Developing a Resilient future for Oldway**

Cllr C Lewis read out the decision from Cabinet meeting held on 5 December as follows -
