Re: Torre Conservative Club, Ground Floor, Quay House, Lansdowne Lane, Torquay

I refer to the above premises and an application for the Grant of a Club Premises Certificate.

Torre Conservative Club presently has a Club Premises Certificate in respect of premises at 31 South Street, Torquay and I am aware that this application has been made to move the location of the club to the Ground Floor of Quay House, Lansdowne Lane, Torquay which is to be specifically adapted for this purpose.


Prior to the submission of this application, my Police Licensing Officer, Mrs Julie Smart, discussed this matter with a representative of the club and indicated that the police would not have any concerns regarding the application provided that the hours and conditions were identical to the existing Club Premises Certificate. However, on reading through the application, it appears that the applicant has neglected to include one condition on this application, this being:

- 1) No entry or re-entry to the premises after 12 midnight.

For your information, within Torquay, all Premises Licences and Club Premises Certificates which allow the sale or supply of intoxicating liquor after midnight have such no entry/re-entry conditions in order to limit the movement of individuals from premises to premises during the early hours of the morning, thereby promoting the crime and disorder and public nuisance licensing objectives. The police therefore request that this condition is imposed on the Club Premises Certificate.
