b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A notice shall be displayed indicating normal hours under the terms of the premises licence during which licensable activities are permitted.

CCTV shall be installed and kept for a minimum of 14 days. People shall be made aware they are on it.

No alcohol shall be allowed on the premises.

Nearby the premises shall be monitored to avoid loiterers.

Employees shall wear a uniform.

c) Public safety

CCTV shall be installed.

All drinks shall be served in plastic or cardboard, no glass.

All exits shall be kept clear of obstruction and clearly identifiable.

All public areas shall have fully operational lighting backed up by emergency lighting.

The entire shop shall be non-smoking.

An incident log book shall be kept.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Deliveries and waste disposal activities shall not take place outside of the area between 23.00 hours - 07.00 hours.

In the vicinity of the premises litter directly related to sales shall be collected and disposed of at the end of each day.

A suitable number of waste receptacles for refuse storage shall be provided.

Patrons shall be asked not to stand around talking in the street outside.

A specific taxi company shall be nominated for staff and customers.

e) The protection of children from harm

Children shall not be permitted after 23.00 hours.

Staff who are under 18 but over 16 shall not be permitted to work after midnight.

Staff under 16 shall not be permitted to work after 1900 hours.
