

ANNEXE 1

MANDATORY CONDITION: WHERE LICENCE AUTHORISES SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL

- 1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:-
 - (a) at a time where there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his/her personal licence is suspended.
- Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
 - (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

ANNEXE 2

CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

General

- 1. Opening hours shall be displayed on the window.
- A sign must be displayed to say who is allowed to buy alcohol,

The Prevention of Crime and Disorder

- 1. CCTV shall be fitted for sale of alcohol: Records shall be kept for 28 days with free access for police.
- Spirits must be displayed behind counter and will be sold by staff over the counter.
- All staff must be trained and made aware of their responsibilities.
- 4. Premises shall be fitted with an alarm system.
- Refusals register shall be kept.

Public Safety

- First aid box must be on the premises.
- All exits must be kept unobstructed.
- All health and safety rules must be kept.
- Staff training shall include having good cooperation with local police and other businesses.
- 5. Premises shall be equipped with fire protection.

ANNEXES continued ...

The Prevention of Public Nuisance

- All deliveries and disposal shall be carried out in the daytime hours.
- 2. Customers and staff must leave the premises in a quiet and calm manner.
- 3. A bin must be provided.

The Protection of Children from Harm

- 1. The shop shall adopt the challenge 21 scheme.
- 2. ID must be asked for when in doubt, a passport, driving licence shall be accepted.
- A register shall be kept on site to identify any persons refused alcohol.
