I am writing to you in your capacity as Designated Supervisor of the above named premises. This is following our meeting on Wednesday 29 June 2016 regarding the following concerns:-

- Friday 22 and Saturday 23 May 2016 at 0445 hours and 0450 hours respectively where a number of persons were in the smoking area and appeared to be socialising, and then appeared to continually drink within the premises. This is beyond the licensable activity times on the licence and under the licensing Act 2003 would be a breach under Section 136 of the Act. Also on Saturday night at 2320 hours police discovered and incident where an alleged altercation took place between a number of excessively drunken males, which resulted in one male punched another. This was confirmed on CCTV at the time of the incident.
- A group of individuals standing outside the premises on Friday 3 June at 1845 hours close to the kerb side on the pavement drinking alcohol. It was highlighted to staff that initially stopped this but soon after the males then reappeared outside along with their drinks. This clearly undermines the licensing Act 2003, and in particular the prevention of crime and disorder and public safety objectives.
- On Friday 28 June at 1700 hours when a male was fast asleep on terraced smoking area of the premises. It appeared to the Officer that the male was sleeping through drunkenness and after being woken up soon went back to sleep again. The male was ejected from the premises when staff was made aware of the situation.

During our discussion you stated that staff will be reminded to be aware of the outside area coupled with a bar monitor to be added to the CCTV system on the premises to help with the supervision of this area. This would help address this matter and improve the supervision of this area throughout the times of trading.

The police would also strongly suggest that you give consideration to supporting the licensing objectives in relation to high levels of drunkenness, which has been highlighted in the above.

On this occasion I am aware that you have taken steps to rectify the expressed concern that have been identified in relation to the premises. Should, however incidents of this nature continue to occur then this may result in further action being taken in relation to the Premises Licence.

Doorstaff assisted in ejecting the person by loosely holding his neck but without force. When they got to the entrance they shoved him away to create a small distance but not excessively and not near the road side.

He has been banned due to suspected drug misuse WEF that night
