Following the arrest of the offenders & return from custody, I visited Winstons & found Amy to be really helpful - not only had she retained the sack of toys, but she also had a good grasp on how their CCTV system works & using their stored footage, was able to quickly find the offenders entering Winstons at 1727hrs that evening - one of whom was carrying the sack of stolen toys. As a result of the handover package, the male offender was charged with theft & the female was released NFA. Amy was really helpful & when I texted her from my PDA the following shift to thank her for her assistance, she replied that she'd burnt off the relevant section of the offenders entering the pub, in case we needed it at a future date.
