Her mother [redacted] was also present who also became very argumentative with officers, [redacted] was arrested for drunk and disorderly and placed into the police van where she continued to scream and shout and banging the cage. Her mother also had to be placed into handcuffs as she became aggressive, she wouldn't leave officers alone and again shouting / swearing in the street. <u>It was clear both females had been inside WINSTONS drinking.</u> [redacted] was taken home by officers.</p>

Established that door steward company is called Fortem Security and owned by John Mudge and S M. Members of the public care for the AP and direct traffic around him.

As a result of our discussions Mike has asked me to apply for a Review of the licence based on the 100% increase in crime, the incident in February where Will Rossindale kicks someones legs from underneath him and this latest incident.

I have arranged a meeting with John Mudge for tomorrow afternoon and will ask him for the details of all 3 door stewards so I can pass this information to PC Tiffany-James.

Log 43 10.03.18 refers to a call made by AP stating he had been assaulted by the door staff who have grabbed him and thrown him out and in the process they have pushed him to the ground causing head injury.	
Upon Police arrival, _____ was located and had 2 open wounds to the rear of his head that were bleeding, he stated that he could not recall what happened other than that he was hit and fell backwards hurting his head – he could not remember who had hit him or description.	
AP's friend, _____ had also been assaulted and his wife stated she saw who did it, but could not pass a description other than a stocky white male.	
Police spoke with door staff who stated that they did not know what happened and had ejected one male but there were no issues.	
Police took _____ and his wife home as he initially refused hospital treatment, but after a few hours he felt ill so went to A&E and had his wounds seen too. It was confirmed that he had 2 cuts on the	

back of his head that had to be glued. One was 1 inch long, the other approx. 2 inches long and were described by the nurse as 'deep wounds'

DPS John MUDGE was asked to burn the CCTV for the incident and leave for officers to collect the following day.

When CCTV was returned via VPU, the CCTV clearly shows the door staff eject a male, believed to be from the premises. is also manhandled out of the premises by door staff and snoved backwards into the road.

There are 3 members of door staff present on the pavement and a and walk back onto the pavement a dispute continues resulting in a member of public punching causing him to stumble backwards onto the road and fall over then gets back to his feet and stumbles onto the pavement where a member of the door staff team shove him with force causing him to fall straight onto his back into the road and hit his head with some force on the tarmac, he is then laid still for several minutes whilst other members of the public attend to him and stop traffic from driving into him.

During this incident where the door staff member shoves, the DPS John MUDGE is stood watching on the pavement along with other members of the door staff team. As lays unconscious on the road, NO members of staff go and help or assist him.

We also had NO calls from door staff or the DPS to report the incident, Police only attended a short while later following a call from which was called in over 10mins after the incident.

For the duration that Police were at WINSTONS the DPS did not approach police to offer any information and was stood outside the front of the building just watching.

CCTV order of events:

00:32:30 stood outside front door of WINSTONS

00:33:12 ejected from WINSTONS and falls to floor. is pushed away by door staff but stays on his feet.

00:33:24 walks back onto pavement and door staff shove him backwards. 3 door staff are seen to be stood out on pavement talking to and

00:33:37 Door staff shove backwards and onto road.

00:33:42 comes onto pavement and is punched by member of public, falls onto floor in road as coach drives around corner. He gets up and stumbles back to pavement.
