I am writing to inform you that your vehicle has been seen illegally parked by Licensing Enforcement Officers. Your Vehicle was seen at 13:46 hrs on Tuesday 8th February 2011, parked outside Natwest Bank, Union Street, Torquay. At this point you were told to move off as there is no waiting as you were parked on double yellow lines. Your vehicle did then move off double yellow lines and at 13:51 hrs you were seen on the loading bay opposite Natwest Bank, Union Street, Torquay again on double yellow lines. In another incident on the 2nd February 2011 at 14:34 hrs your vehicle was again seen parked illegally on double yellow lines outside Natwest Bank, Union Street, Torquay.

As we have reminded you in previous correspondence you should not be parking illegally at any time and you were warned that any further breaches of parking regulations could result in you being brought before the Licensing Committee to explain your actions.

From our records we have recently written to you, (Ref: SRU155332, dated 25th October 2010) regarding illegal parking on Union Street, Torquay on another separate occasion. As a result of this I would now like you to write to me as soon as possible and in no case no later than 7 days from receipt of this letter to explain your actions as to why you think it is acceptable to be carrying on breaking parking regulations. On receipt of this information the Licensing Manger will decide whether to take the matter to Licensing Committee for actioning.
