Have your say on exciting plans for a multi-million pound project to help regenerate Torquay Town Centre, bring council services under one roof and make major savings.

Torbay Council has approved the business case for the Hub which is being managed by the Torbay Development Agency.

The Council has already consulted on this project and the design team has reflected those comments in the current plans for the Town Hall. This is another opportunity to provide your feedback on the refurbishment of the listed Town Hall and Assembly Room before the planning application is submitted.

Two consultation events will be run on:

- Tuesday 21 July (9am - 5.30pm) in the Town Hall's Assembly Hall
- Wednesday 22 July (9am - 5.30pm) in the Town Hall's Assembly Hall

Exhibition boards and surveys will also be available between Monday 20 July and Friday 24 July in Torquay Library, Brixham Library and Oldway Mansion.
