
Terms and Conditions:

- By applying to join the Torbay Junior Steel Band, students and their parents commit to ensuring attendance at all rehearsals and performances unless absolutely unavoidable. In this case Annabelle should be informed with as much notice as possible.
- There are six teaching sessions this half term. Each term a session schedule is distributed. Please keep this in a safe place and refer to it each week to check that rehearsals are taking place. If any change is made to the rehearsal, you will be informed in writing, via email.
- Band members will be provided with music folders and music. These should be brought along to every rehearsal.
- During teaching sessions, members should follow all instructions given by tutors and supervisors. These instructions are given for reasons of safety and quality musical instruction and performance.
- Successful music-making requires good team-work. Members are expected to treat tutors, supervisors and each other with respect. Bullying, in all its forms, will not be tolerated.
- Members are expected to treat the accommodation with respect and care and to leave it in the state in which it was found. All litter should be picked up and chairs put away at the end of each rehearsal.
- When out in public, best behaviour is expected at all times. Poor behaviour reflects badly upon Torbay Steel Bands, Torbay Music Service and Torbay Council.
- All the terms and conditions above are designed to make activities as enjoyable and accessible as possible for all students. Persistent rulebreaking by one member could spoil the experience for others. In these very rare cases, the Music Development Coordinator may choose to ask offending members to leave. In this situation, subscriptions will not be returned.
