2) APPROVAL OF MINUTES of meeting held on 18 July 2005

3) CORRESPONDENCE

4) COMMUNITY PLAN REVIEW

Progress on

- a) Snooty Fox development – cameras. Cameras at point of being installed. Will be finished by the end of the year.
- b) Signs for bike racks – no progress.
- c) Maintenance of Foxlands Walk – AC reported that there had been an on site meeting between AF, AC and residents which had reached an impasse until there was cooperation from the landowners.
- d) St Marychurch Town Hall development. Members were disappointed to learn that the development has been approved without any increase in the proposal for 3 public toilets in the car park opposite to replace those 8 lost.
- e) Demolition/Closure of Shelters – MB mentioned that the shelters were offered up as a business opportunity. AC will inform traders.

5) AOB

Late night noise nuisance

Valerie Wallace, owner of Aspects shop, St Marychurch, attended the meeting to raise the problem of a broken window sustained to her premises as a result of a loud party held at the St Marychurch Town Hall site the previous Saturday. There was general discussion concerning late night noise nuisance in Reddenhill Road. There is to be a change in the law resulting in SIA (security industry approved) officers to be at every takeaway and pub.

Project funding

AC suggested that we should have a list of priorities.

Involvement of other groups in the WP

Torbay VS has a list of organisations/groups/schools etc whom we can contact.

Babbacombe Festival

AC has an organisations list for 2007 Babbacombe Festival which will take place over a 10-day period around Babbacombe and asked if there are any to add. He also mentioned that there was to be a meeting on November 2nd at the town hall re Brunel 200 at 9.30 to 1pm

Traffic problems

There was a general discussion concerning the problems traffic congestions in Manor Road, the right hand side going down. AF will speak to Steve Hirley about what can be done about double yellow lines, or cones making parking illegal.

Concerning parking, AF mentioned that residential parking is being phased in over the next 2 to 3 years.

Concerning Western Road. A no entry sign has been put up but it is still a rat run. This was noted by Police officers present.

GA Building

The future of the GA Building was raised. CH said there is to be a preplanning meeting. The Chairman requested that the WP be consulted at an early stage.

AF mentioned that planning applications are placed on the Torbay Gov website.
