## **Tower Wagon Operators Safe Working Practices**

---

Existing legislation, codes of practice and your employer's requirements on health and safety at work, require that you comply with the following:-

1. Always ensure out-riggers are down and locked in position before entering bucket.
2. On inclines, wheels are to be chocked and the driver must stay in cab.
3. All necessary road warning signs to be displayed.
4. Safety harness to be worn at all times when in bucket.
5. Riding in bucket is forbidden.
6. Do not carry out repairs to lanterns on South Western Electricity Board poles carrying overhead power lines.
7. Bucket not to be used within radius of 6ft. (2m) from live overhead cables.
8. Low source columns - Use of Ladders: Ensure ladder is footed.
9. Fluorescent jackets to be worn when working on or near highway.
10. If an accident occurs ensure that an Accident Form is completed and details entered on the Accident Form as soon as possible. See Accident Reports and Investigations.
11. If in doubt consult your Manager.
