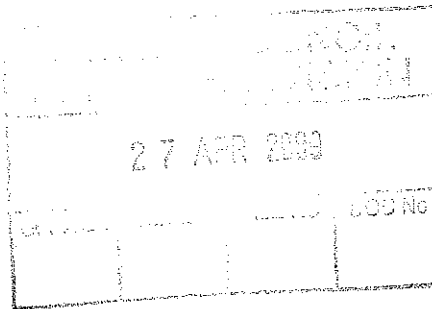

Re: Kim Saigon Restaurant, 50 Torwood Street, Torquay

I refer to an application for the Grant of a Premises Licence in respect of the above premises.

The police have no objections to the application, but consider that the following conditions should be imposed:

1. A CCTV system of an evidential standard to be installed to the satisfaction of the police, and the system to be in operation at all times the premises are open to the public. All recordings from that system to be kept for a period of 14 days and the police to have access to recordings at any reasonable time.
2. The sale and consumption of all alcohol will be restricted to persons sat at tables, consuming a meal at the premises.

For your information, the premises are situated within your Cumulative Impact Area and the police consider that by having an effective CCTV system, it will provide effective evidence to the police in the event of crime and disorder and provide reassurance to both staff and customers.

The condition re the sale and consumption of all alcohol being restricted to persons consuming meals will ensure that the premises are run as a restaurant and that persons will not be able to use the establishment for vertical drinking.
