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Questions you may have...

What happens next?

The consultation period ends on 26th February at which point the Care Trust and the partners involved in this proposal will consider the responses received.

We will then discuss the findings with Torbay Council and prepare a design for the proposed centre ahead of a planning application. This new design will be available in a number of places, including Grosvenor and Withycombe Lodge GP surgeries, Midvale Clinic, Paignton Library and on the Care Trust website.

How do you intend to pay for this project?

This centre would bring together a number of services currently provided in separate buildings, and will therefore save money in running costs.

The Care Trust has particular elements of its budget to use for developments of this type.

Will there be parking & public transport links?

One of the reasons for choosing this site is because of its public transport links. There would also be parking available on site.

I'm a patient of Grosvenor/Withycombe. Will I still be able to see my current doctor?

Yes. Your GP and the practice staff and services would all move to the new purpose built centre.

How else can I get involved with this project?

The Care Trust and other partners involved in this project will be holding a Public Meeting in January — details will be published across Torbay and in the media. Please come along to hear more about our plans and share your thoughts.
