

Report OSB/9/05 of the Overview and Scrutiny Board to the meeting of the Executive to be held on 12th July 2005

REVISION TO FRAUD SANCTION POLICY

- 1. At ism eeting on 18th May 2005, the Overview and Scrutiny Board considered Report 27/2005, which inform ed Mem bersof the proposed revisions to the Council's Fraud Sanction Policy.
- 2. The Reportasked the Board to endorse the revised fraud sanction policies which, if in plem ented, would bring the Councilin line with governm entguidelines.
- 3. The Department forW ork and Pensions (DW P) monetary guidelines regarding administration penalties and cautions changed from Novem ber 2004, and the current Council policy does not reflect these changes. From 11th Novem ber 2004 the DW P is now giving more consideration to the individual custom er's circum stances when deciding the appropriateness of using a formal caution or offering an administrative penalty for fraud if the:
 - evidential mequimement for prosecution is satisfied, and
 - overpaymentisless than £2,000
- 4. Therefore based on these changes and the fact that jointworking is to be considered in all cases involving Housing/CouncilTax Benefit and a relevant DW P administered benefit, it is felt that it is necessary to am end the policy currently being used by Torbay Council to bring it into line with DW P practice and guidelines.
- 5. The Board fully endorses the revised fraud sanction policy and there fore recommends that the Executive accepts and approves the revised Fraud Sanction policies.
