3.	Matters Arising	Action
(a)	Gateway signage  KM made the Forum aware that until the new ferry and bus stop signage was decided he would defer any action at Torquay.  JT stated that a new car park directional sign and a new finger sign – "To the Harbour" had now been erected at Paignton. There had been some difficulty in making the argument for the need for Paignton harbour to have its own 'Brown Sign'. JR agreed to pursue this matter.  JF made it clear that in her opinion enough work had now been done on this matter in support of harbour businesses.	JR
(b)	Tor Bay Harbour – Port Master Plan KM reported that following the stakeholder event in October a number of drop-in sessions had been held and the ideas submitted circulated to all on the email distribution list. A number of further comments /suggestions had been made and the intention was to publicise and circulate the link to a final draft before the Plan is presented to the Harbour Committee in June.	KM
(c)	Harbour Charges and Budget 2013/4 KM stated that the Budget and Charges had been submitted to and agreed by the Harbour Committee in December 2012. Invoices for the coming year had been prepared and posted.	
(d)	Blue Sea Food Company KM made the Forum aware that a special meeting of the Harbour Committee had agreed to extend the lease of the area of land outside the premises until December 2013. The company would therefore have the rest of the year before they needed to move their container. The planning officer had already issued an enforcement notice to this effect and in the meantime the company's managers had agreed to work with the harbour team to minimise the impact of their operation. JT confirmed that this had started to happen.  In response to a question from AB, KM explained the background and the company's future plans as he understood them.	JT/KM
(e)	Harbour Marketing KM reminded the Forum of the e-marketing being carried out for Tor Bay Harbour and that there was now a half-page advert in the Paignton section of the English Riviera Guide.	

4.	Capital Works	Action
4. (a)	Haldon Pier – update  KM reported that the small amount of concrete spraying had been completed but the small amount of rock armour was yet to be placed at the outer end of the quay. Repairs to the inside of the wall, within the balance of the current funding package, would be put out to competitive tender. In response to a question from WB, KM stated that the equipment and vehicles on the pier were associated with the works going on at Princess Gardens but the space would be managed to ensure that there was minimal effect on any forthcoming events. 4.	Capital Works	Action
(b)	Princess Pier – update KM reminded the Forum that all of the works to the concrete part of the pier were subject to EA funding and that the bid had not yet been submitted. The remaining works to Princess Pier were in the Council's Capital Plan.	KM/DS
(c)	Torquay inner harbour pontoon berths - update KM reported that the scheme had now been approved by full Council. It would be project managed by the TDA with a delivery date of 1 <sup>st</sup> April 2014. In response to questions KM stated that the entry access point was yet to be finally agreed bit he expected it to be from Victoria Parade and that charges were to be circa halfway between existing inner harbour fees and the Town Dock rates. KM went on to say that some pontoon berths had already been created on South Pier and these had sold very quickly at the new charge. WB asked if existing customers would have a phased increase. KM indicated that this had not yet been decided.

	KM stated that he had circulated the Harbour Business Plan for 2013/14 and he	ALL

6.	Changes to the Tor Bay Harbour Moorings Policy	Action
	KM made the Forum aware of the proposed changes to this policy concerning the reduction in time that anyone could sub-let a facility and also some clarification on the time that users could hold a facility without their vessel on it. There were no objections to these changes from the Forum.	KM

7.	Marine Conservation Zones - consultation response	Action
	KM reported that the Government had announced the consultation process for MCZs in December 2012. He said that he would prepare a response which, subject to Harbour Committee approval, would then be to be submitted to Defra. He believed the initial MCZ designation process undertaken by Finding Sanctuary had not properly included 'sea users' and that development opportunities for Tor Bay Harbour would be lost if the Torbay MCZ was introduced as proposed. He made the Forum aware that he had raised this issue with the Tourism Company, Business Forum, the Yacht/Sailing Clubs, fishing industry and other user groups, urging them to respond to the Defra consultation. There followed considerable debate regarding the consequences of the rMCZ for Torbay. The Forum agreed that there would be negative socio-economic impacts arising from this proposed designation.	KM

KM/JT	KM gave the Forum the background as to why enforcement continued to be necessary in Paignton and at Torquay. He also summarised why the Council's own enforcement procedure was ineffective and inappropriate for the harbour estate. Many other harbours use a private contractor with no cost and they utilise harbour staff during normal working hours. JT explained that at Paignton all the businesses that had been consulted welcomed this proposal. The Mayor raised some concerns about using a contractor from outside the Torbay area, especially as the Council, along with others, were losing jobs. GO said he could not support a scheme that brought workers in from outside Torbay. JT stated that the company would recruit people from within the Bay to carry out the evening work. The Mayor did however support the principle of harbour staff issuing enforcement notices. KM

3.	Matters Arising	Action
(a)	Electricity Recharge Project PL informed the Forum that the system is due to go live on the 1 <sup>st</sup> March, with the MFV basin and the crane pier both having the facilities to now recharge all electricity used. The recharge costs will be the exact cost of what the harbour authority is being charged plus a small administration fee.	
(b)	Port Master Plan PL informed the Forum that the initial Port Master Plan will be circulated for comment within the next month. The Plan will be subject to a 5 year review, and it is hoped that the Council will be adopting the Plan in July. PL also reported that the drop-in sessions that were held in February were a great success and the harbour authority had received good feedback from a number of stakeholders.	
(c)	Fenders and Capping project PL reported that the harbour authority already had Committee agreement to upgrade the fenders and replace the ladders around the harbour. He indicated that quotes were currently being obtained and a decision would be made in April about whether or not the project had enough funding to proceed.	PL
(d)	Harbourside cranes PL stated that the harbour authority were applying to the European Fisheries Fund for funding to help purchase two new cranes for day boat fish landing on the quayside.	PL
(e)	Yacht Club slipway PL agreed that he would obtain an exact quote for the works to be carried out on the Yacht Club slipway and he would pass the quote to the Club.	PL
4.	Northern Arm Business plan	
	PL informed the Forum that the Northern Arm Business Case report was nearing completion. He said that the Business Case should be reported to the Harbour Committee on the 18 <sup>th</sup> March. The report will look at various funding options and ways in which to take the Northern Arm project forward.	
5.	Recruitment	
	PL informed the Forum that the harbour authority had appointed three new Dock Masters over the Christmas/New Year period and they have settled in well. Further recruitment was underway to replace John Heath who had retired.  The Assistant Harbour Master position, that has been vacant for some time is still in the process of being approved by the Council but this should be approved for recruitment shortly.	PL
6.	Frequent Ferry Project	
	PL reported that there were no bidders for the new ferry service but the Council were continuing forward with the project. The new pontoons will be installed at Brixham and Torquay. A new bidding process for a ferry operator would start soon.  Page 161	

# 7. Moorings Maintenance PL informed the Forum that TMS were in their third and final year of the mooring maintenance contract and they had proved to be very successful. He indicated that the mooring inspections were due to start, this year, in a couple of weeks and they would be completed before the boat re-launch on the 28<sup>th</sup> March.
