Lease Renewal of Unit 12 Union Square, Torquay

Decision Taker and Date Decision Taken:

Director of Finance on 25 September 2024.

Summary of Matter or Issue Requiring Decision:

The Tenant, Thi Le Ha is currently occupying under a lease dated 15th February 2022, trading as a nail bar. The lease has come to an end, to avoid the Tenant acquiring protection under the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954, the occupation now needs to be documented by way of a lease renewal.

Decision Taken:

That the lease for Unit 12 Union Square, Torquay be renewed with the existing tenant, namely Thi Le Ha, for a three-year period.

Summary of Reason(s) for Decision Taken:

The lease terms have been agreed in principle between the Council's retained agent and Tenant direct on commercially acceptable terms.

Summary of Alternatives or Options considered and rejected and Background Papers:

The Council may choose not to grant the lease of this property. However, this could result in the Tenant claiming protection under the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954, which may hinder future development of the Shopping Centre.
