APPEALS COMMITTEE (TRANSPORT) AGENDA

1. Election of Chairman

To elect a Chairman for the meeting.

2. Apologies for absence

3. Declarations of interest

(a) To receive declarations of non pecuniary interests in respect of items on this agenda

(b) To receive declarations of disclosable pecuniary interests in respect of items on this agenda

For reference: Where a Member has a disclosable pecuniary interest he/she must leave the meeting during consideration of the item. However, the Member may remain in the meeting to make representations, answer questions or give evidence if the public have a right to do so, but having done so the Member must then immediately leave the meeting, may not vote and must not improperly seek to influence the outcome of the matter. A completed disclosure of interests form should be returned to the Clerk before the conclusion of the meeting.

4. Urgent Items

5. Exclusion of the Press and Public
