Supporting People:

What is provided?

Torbay Council is the Administering Authority for the Supporting People programme. The Council commissions services in partnership with Torbay & Southern Devon Health Care Trust (TSDFHCT) and Devon and Cornwall Probation Service to promote the independence of vulnerable people.

The Supporting People service commissions housing related support for Torbay's vulnerable people with a local connection, who need support to remain living independently. Services intervene early to prevent the greater financial and social cost of acute responses to incidents such as, threatened homelessness, poor mental health and domestic abuse.

In supporting resettlement, recovery and re-ablement following crises including, homelessness, hospitalisation or residential care the spend on statutory services, particularly social care and housing is avoided or reduced.

Why is it provided?

There is no statutory requirement for Supporting People but the programme plays a key role in delivering the Council's statutory duties in relation to homelessness and children, families and young people, crime and disorder and public health.
