I am employed by Devon & Somerset Fire and Rescue as a Watch Manager, based in Newton Rd Torquay and have been employed by the Fire Service for 30 years.

I cannot recall the exact date, but it was a Friday, about 3-4 weeks ago. I was on my way home from work, at around 5pm, when I decided to stop in Belgrave Rd, Torquay to buy a newspaper in the small newsagents just down from the Tav Abbey Pub.

I pulled my car over and parked directly outside the shop, which is only about 10 yards further down from the Tav Abbey Pub.

I got out of my car onto the pavement and as I walked towards the newsagents, I suddenly heard a loud ~~car~~<sup>cr</sup> crash and saw a man stagger out from inside the pub.

This man was a tall man, about 6'2" aged about 50 yrs. of age, of tanned complexion and with a bald head.

He staggered but didn't fall over and he was followed out by a male I recognized as [redacted] who I've known for many years.

I heard [redacted] shout in a threatening manner words similar to "whose fucking throwing who out". He clearly directed these comments towards the male who I saw stagger out from inside the pub, behind me.

[redacted] said nothing more and returned inside the pub, followed by the male. Nobody else was involved and it appeared to me that there had been an altercation inside.

Nothing else happened and I went into the vending machine, made my purchase and returned to my car and went on home.

When I witnessed this incident I was only about 10 feet from it.

[redacted] was wearing working clothes and I couldn't tell if he was under the influence of alcohol. The male who got thrown out was not aggressive towards [redacted] and I can't remember what he was wearing.

I am Police Constable 3287 of the Devon and Cornwall Constabulary currently stationed at Torquay Police Station as the Neighbourhood Beat Manager for the Torre area. I currently have twenty-three year's service.

I commenced duties in Torre on the 11<sup>th</sup> of May 2009. As part of my duties I liaise with a large range of people. These include residents, visitors, and businesses.

Following a serious assault at the Tor Abbey Public House on Sunday the 24<sup>th</sup> of May 2009 I was requested to speak to the local community for two reasons. Firstly to gain any evidence to assist my colleagues in the C.I.D. department and secondly to judge the impact an incident like this has on the local community. My findings were as follows.

I visited all business and private premises around the area of the Tor Abbey Inn. The most notable comment made from all the people I spoke to was that they would not use this public house. When asked why the reply from all people asked was this was a 'rough' pub and was not frequented by local people. When asked if they would make a complaint with reference to any such incident the reply was no. The main reason for this was for fear of reprisals from the users of the public house. A number of the business owners did state they had not been

affected directly from the pub or its customers as they did not live in the area and during the day there were no problems.

Three people I spoke to, who are residents, made significant comments but as I have already mentioned they would not make a written statement. Their statements were as follows.

"I used to walk down that side of Belgrave Road and past the Tor Abbey Inn. When I did walk past the door there were always people stood outside the entrance smoking. I would get lewd comments from men like "Nice Arse". The language was also foul and this was at lunch times as well as the evenings. I now walk on the other side of the road".

"I went in the Tor Abbey Inn once when I first moved into the area. I was made to feel very uncomfortable. The pub was obviously inhabited by regulars and I was just stared at and the atmosphere was very intimidating. I have been in pubs all over the UK and have never felt like this. I would never go in again".

"I live close by the Tor Abbey Inn and on a regular basis I am kept awake by the loud noise coming not just from the music but also from the shouting. I accept that during opening hours a pub has to run a business but as I work during the day I have been kept awake at varying time from midnight to 03:00hrs in the morning. The music has been blaring out and a lot of drunken people have been both inside and outside shouting and screaming. The pub has no respect for locals who are trying to sleep, the pub will often have its doors and windows wide open especially in the hot weather. I do not know what time they are supposed to finish but the drinking carries on until the early hours. The worst nights are at the weekend (Friday and Saturday) but it also happens on a Wednesday evening. I was told when I moved in that the Tor Abbey Inn had a bad reputation with local residents. On one occasion I had locked myself out and needed to use the toilet. It was about 13:00hrs on a week day. When I went into the toilet there were two men in the same cubicle. They both came out and I could clearly see white powder on their noses and there were sniffing and wiping around their noses laughing. I am sure they were taking Cocaine. I have never been back in since".

At 00:36 on 28/11/09 the pub landlord had turned down the lights to encourage customers to leave when the AP could be seen to stagger backwards following some sort of altercation. CCTV shows this but the offender is not in view. AP then leaves the pub and returns home which is some twenty seconds away. There is no footage of anything untoward outside the pub but the AP has woken up with a swollen left cheek and four lacerations to his legs with corresponding cuts to his trousers. He states that he was so drunk he does not remember anything about how he received his injuries. The landlord says he was aware that a male had been slapped but of nothing else. The AP and his house mate both state that cocaine is snorted in the pub. They state the stairs off the back room are used to gain access to the first floor and that the landlord is involved. They say there are numerous customers leave the bar and return a short while later wiping away secretions from their noses. There is no direct evidence to link this assault with customers from the pub but it is extremely likely given the proximity of the AP's HA to the pub.

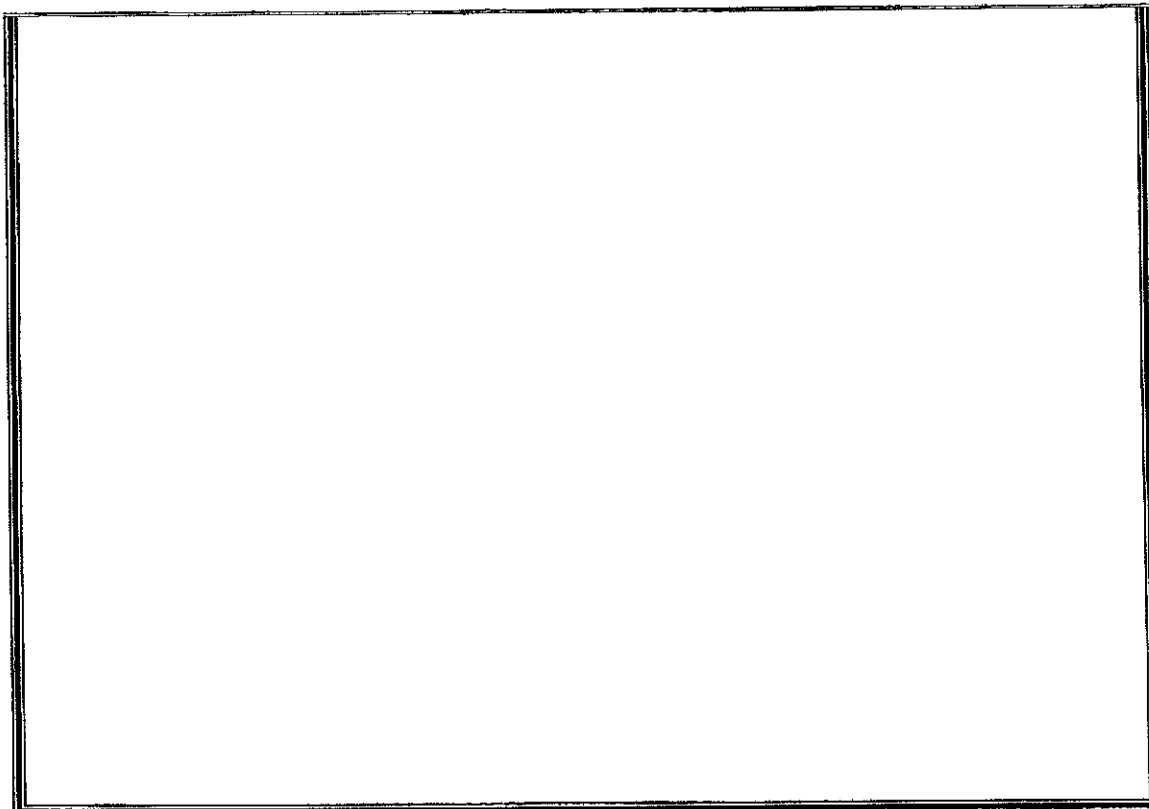
