Hi

I have concerns about two pubs operating in close proximity in Belgrave Road. The Tor Abbey Inn has karaoke every Saturday night. Last weekend, when I let the dog out at 11-15pm, I could hear the noise from my house, [REDACTED] There are people living upstairs above all the shops and there are also houses immediately opposite. Some of these have young children in them. The level of sound is unacceptable.

This afternoon I went down Tor Church Road and there were half a dozen men, customers of the Bull and Bush Pub, all with there drinks on the opposite side of the road standing in the sunshine. This is an alcofree area. I spoke to the shop owner whose windowsill they were propped up on, and he said it is the same every time the sun is shining. This goes on all afternoon from about 2pm when the hotel staff working split shifts come off duty.

Hope you can do something about these issues.

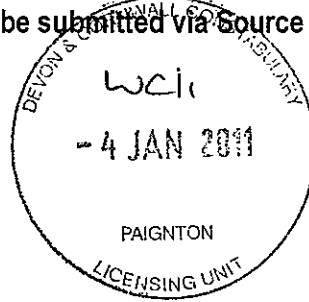

**Subject: ISSUES AT THE TORRE ABBEY INN, BELGRAVE ROAD,

I attended the above PH at approx 0500 01/01/11 following a report of the landlord of pub having been assaulted and a number of people fighting.

I entered to find PC 1481 Barnard and PC 2673 Stevenson in attendance. PC 1481 Barnard was tending to the landlord who was injured and on the floor in the pub. Chairs had been upturned with glasses on the floor. It appeared as if there had been a fight in the pub. There were approximately 10 people in the pub drinking at the bar.

I tried to ascertain what had happened from those present by identifying witnesses. I was immediately spoken to by a woman customer who said it was a private party (curtains were drawn on entry). Then another male stated that it wasn't as alcohol was allowed to be served New Year. There clearly was alcohol being served and I approached the lady behind the bar who gave her details as [REDACTED] born [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] if she was the DPS but as she didn't understand I asked her if she was the landlady. She said she wasn't and that the landlord was on the floor and the landlady was with him (pointing out Jill Cave). Jill then went upstairs with PC Stevenson to view CCTV. I asked [REDACTED] if she was working and she said no and I asked her why she was pouring drinks from behind the bar. She said that she was only pouring drinks as the landlord wasn't able to as he was on the floor. I told her she shouldn't be serving and to stop which she did. I then asked her to describe what had happened and she seemed reluctant to do so. As other customers were constantly trying to chip in with their versions I asked her to come with me to the back room to discuss matters in private which she did, albeit reluctantly and nervously. I took down her version in my PNB and then returned to the bar to find another male going to help himself to a drink behind the bar. Again I stopped this happening by advising he was not able to do so.

I spoke to another customer and took her account and she asked if it was ok to smoke a cigarette. The pub reeked of cigarette smoke and clearly customers had been smoking within the pub before we got there.

Other customers were reluctant to give their details and some point blank refused without giving explanation. The landlord was seen by paramedics but apparently refused to go to hospital. He also refused to give an account to PC Barnard and was saying he was going to sort things out himself. He was clearly very in drink as was the other DPS Jill Cave.

I spoke to Jill Cave in private and tried to appeal to her to get Roger to make a statement in the morning after they had had time to calm down. In fact she was also assaulted as were two other customers who tried to help the landlord.

There is very good CCTV evidence which they have been asked to preserve until later today as it needs burning off.

In summary, there appeared to be a number of breaches of licence, both DPS's were on premises well in drink, no substitute was paid to serve, and there was clear evidence of smoking. There was a definite reluctance to assist the Police with the investigation of what could have been a very serious assault.

I am the above named person and I am the Landlord of The Tor Abbey Inn public House located along Belgrave Road Torquay. Tor Abbey Inn is a licensed premise which sells alcoholic drinks to customers. I would describe my pub as a local pub. Tor Abbey Inn has a main entrance which leads into the main bar area. I would estimate the size of the main bar as being 8 meters by 7 meters. There are several table and chairs a large 50 inch television on the wall, a juke box. There is also a small bar to the rear of the pub which has a pool table and a darts board. I have been the landlord at the pub for 10 years.

During this statement I will be referring to a male who assaulted me I would describe the Male as a White male, 5ft 10in tall to 6ft and of stocky build. I would say his age is from late 20's to early 30's. This male was wearing a blue checked shirt. I did not take a lot of notice of this male and I would not be able to recognise his face. I have not seen this male before.

On Friday 31st December 2010 I was working behind the bar along with Jill CAVE. Jill and I are partners. I was dressed as a French Maid and Jill was dressed a man in a suit. We dress up every year as a bit of fun for the evening.

The pub was very busy as it was New Years Eve and as midnight approached I would describe the pub

At this address, I spoke with a person who I will now refer to as Witness A. The person does not wish to be identified as the person is fearful of reprisals for themselves and family. The reprisals could range from verbal abuse, harassment or potentially physical violence.

Witness A stated that they hve lived at their address for a number of years.

Witness A lives near to the Tor Abbey Public House, Belgrave Road, Torquay and from their address, have a good view of the pub and surrounding area.

Witness A informed me that there have been problems with anti social behaviour in the pub, particularly since the current landlord and lady took over in 2000-2001.

Witness A has seen on occasions, people urinating in the street. These people have come out of the pub and urinated around some steps which lead from Belgrave Road into Lime Avenue. The urinating according to Witness A can happen at any time. In particular, people who have gone out to make a phone call or to smoke are more likely to urinate.

Witness A then informed me about people drinking on the street outside the pub. This normally happens during a busy weekend and more so in the summer. The longer they are out in the street, the rowdier they become. This also brings the problem of broken glass. Witness A lastly mentioned that people often cross the street to avoid the drinkers which is believed due to intimidation.

Witness A lastly mentioned about drug dealing involving the clientele in the pub. On numerous occasions, the last being in January 2011, Witness A has seen the passing of money and bags of white powder outside the pub whereby the person selling the bag has gone back into the pub.

Witness A did state that in fairness to the landlord and lady, they have not been observed by witness A at anytime taking part in drug related activity.

Although Witness A could not offer specific dates and times for incidents, the courses of conduct outlined to me appear to be an ongoing matter.

Witness A lastly stated that the problems with the Tor Abbey Public house cause them annoyance as it does to other residents in the area.

I have interrogated the Devon and Cornwall Police Force Computer Information System. I can confirm that there are currently 83 police incidents recorded against the Pub since 24th April 1999. The incidents range from fights, alleged drug dealing, thefts in the pub and high level assaults. Since 15th October 2009, there have been three police incidents recorded.

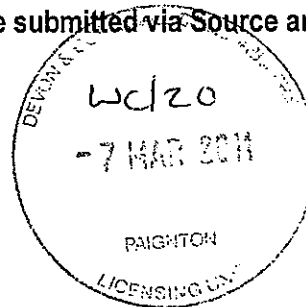
