Recommendations and Actions



Elective Home Education An Overview from the January 2022 Audit

Key Actions:

- Resolve the backlog of cases and return to an immediate assessment.
- Formalise processes that have been initiated in light of the backlog to improve consistency.
- Set to work the new Capita One module with associated templates to improve accuracy and completeness.
- Return to home visits for cases causing concern.
- **TORBAY** COUNCIL Improve partnership working – particularly with reference to long term missing and children 'below' partner thresholds.

Next Steps
