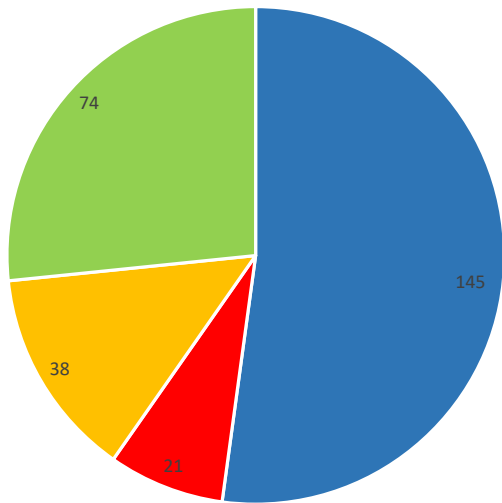


# Elective Home Education Trend – Torbay



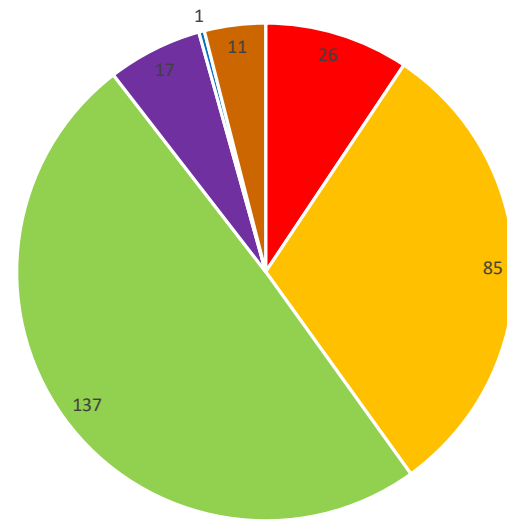

RAG ratings of electively home educated



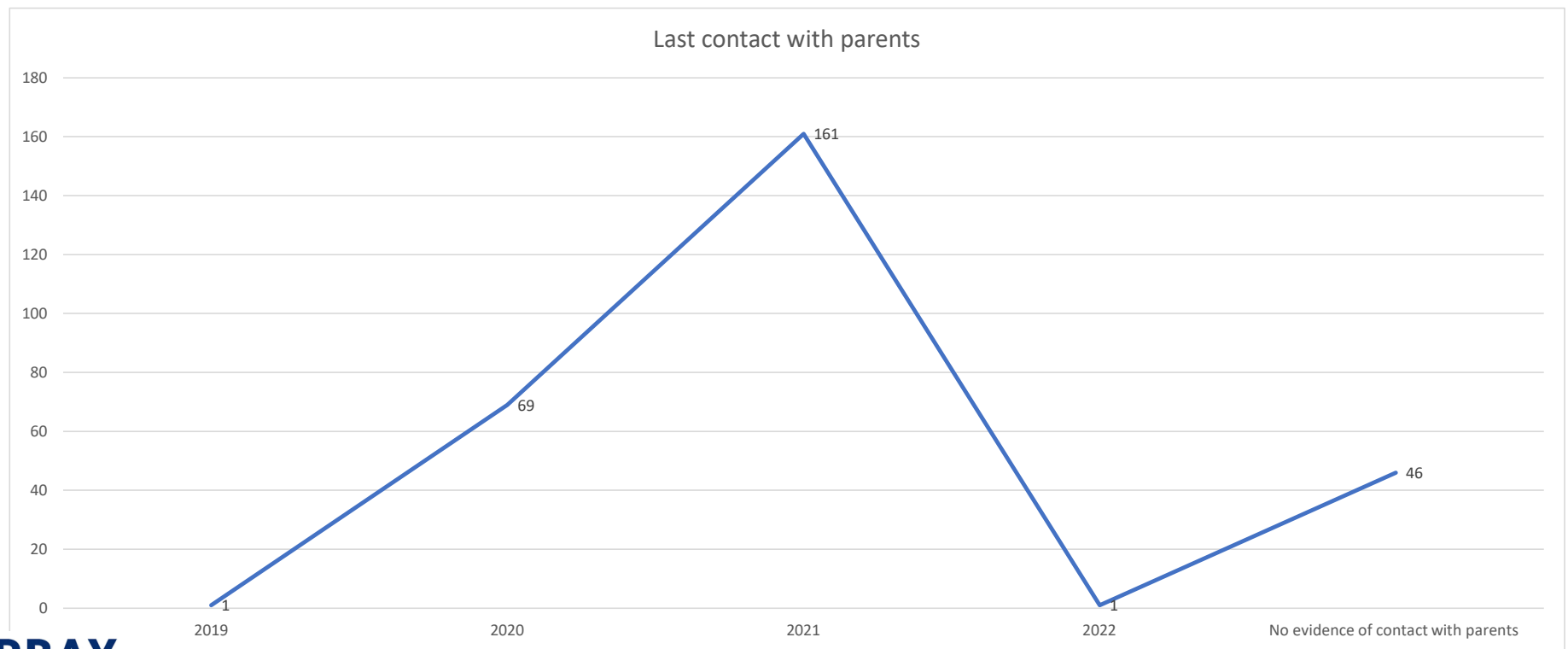

# Elective Home Education

## An Overview from the January 2022 Audit

### Key Actions:

- Resolve the backlog of cases and return to an immediate assessment.
- Formalise processes that have been initiated in light of the backlog to improve consistency.
- Set to work the new Capita One module with associated templates to improve accuracy and completeness.
- Return to home visits for cases causing concern.
- Improve partnership working – particularly with reference to long term missing and children ‘below’ partner thresholds.

An in-depth review of children's records who are EHE has taken place. Findings are being collated in respect of this and a report will be available soon.
