- Identifying all ASC contracts held by the Trust to form one contract register for full visibility
- Decision on whether to continue/extend/novate or procure contracts
- Specifications for Hollacombe and Carers services
- Development of a commissioning handbook
- Arrangements for staff, to create a joint commissioning function

Strategic Commissioning: BAU

- Commissioning Oversight Group – across Adults, Children’s and Public Health
- Cross-cutting commissioning opportunities – with Public Health and Children’s, particularly on high cost/demand areas where we can jointly shape the market
- Provider engagement – forums, newsletters
- Engagement and information sharing with CQC
- Links with ADASS working groups
