Dear Mandy

I have had useful discussions with Julie Smart and as a consequence we have reached an agreement on points 2 -10 in their letter to you of the 15<sup>th</sup> January.

The police have agreed not to pursue the conditions **numbered 3,4,7 and 8** in their letter.

Our clients will agree their requested condition **number 2**. This will take the place of conditions numbered 4 and 5 on the Application

We have agreed suggested amended wording to the conditions requested by the police and numbered **5, 6, 9 and 10** as follows:-

5. All refusals will be detailed in a Refusals Book, which shall be retained at the premises and be available for inspection by the police or members of the local authority licensing team at any reasonable. All records shall be kept for a minimum of 12 months.

6. The company website shall display the following message in a prominent position.  
"Customers are reminded that it is a criminal offence for a person under 18 to purchase or attempt to purchase alcohol and it is also an offence to purchase alcohol on behalf of a person under 18".

9. The terms and conditions of the sale of alcohol, as detailed on the company website, shall state: "The company and its employees have the right to refuse the sale of alcohol whenever they feel a refusal is appropriate, ie where they consider that underage drinking may occur at the premises, where they are not satisfied with the ID produced or where they consider that the customer is drunk".

10. All licence conditions shall be part of the Terms and Conditions, which must be displayed on the website

**Condition number 1** is not agreed and this will therefore be the main issue to be determined by the sub-committee, provided of course they agree the matters set out above
