- a) General all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)
- 1. Management shall maintain close liaison with the Police Neighbourhood Beat Manager for the area in which the premises is situated
- 2. The premises shall be a member of any Pubwatch scheme operating in Brixham, and participate in any "Night-Net" scheme that might operate in the Town
- 3. Management, or a designated senior staff member, shall attend local licensing meetings arranged by the police or Licensing Authority
- 4. Overall, the sale of alcohol shall be ancillary to those of food and other beverages

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- 1. Subject to any regulatory limitations placed on this listed building, a CCTV system shall be installed, operated and maintained having regard to advice received from the police Licensing Officer. Images obtained shall be of evidential standard, shall be retained for at least fourteen days and, subject to data protection or other primary legislation, shall be made available to the Responsible Authorities at any reasonable time
- 2.Glasses and bottles shall be removed from public areas as soon as practicable after they are finished with or emptied
- 3. Alcohol sold for consumption off the premises shall be in sealed containers only
- 4. Management shall display a prominent commitment to the deployment, where requested by the police, of equipment or resources directed by the police, and designed to prevent or detect drugs offences
- 5. Management shall, where they are operated, participate in schemes designed to facilitate communication with the police, CCTV control rooms or other licensed premises in the Town
- 6. In respect of the balcony area on the first floor and the outside seating area on the ground floor, all customers consuming alcohol shall be seated at all times, and all drinks must be served to customers in those areas in either toughened, shatter-proof, polycarbonate or plastic glasses
- 7. In respect of the balcony area on the first floor and the outside seating area on the ground floor, no drinks shall be served in glass bottles from which it is intended, or likely, that a person shall drink

c) Public safety

- 1. The fire safety measures with which the premises are provided shall be maintained in good working order and their adequacy shall be determined on a regular basis by the performance of a risk assessment
- 2. Management shall ensure that all staff are trained in relation to the premises' emergency evacuation procedure, and their role in the event of a fire or other emergency. A record of this training shall be maintained and produced to the Responsible Authorities
- 2. Suitable and sufficient first aid equipment shall be made available for the use of customers and staff
- d) The prevention of public nuisance

- 1. Prominent, clear, and legible notices shall be displayed at all public exits requesting patrons to leave the premises, and the area, quietly
- 2.Bottles, or other glass waste, shall not be deposited into bins or other receptacles outside the premises after 21:00 or before 09:00
- 3. The outside area on the ground floor shall not be used for the consumption of alcohol after 22:00
- 4. Management shall take steps to minimise potential nuisance caused by taxis collecting customers from the premises

e) The protection of children from harm

- 1. The "Challenge 25" scheme shall be operated at the premises.
- 2. Staff engaged in the retail sale of alcohol who are not holders of a Personal Licence shall receive training in the legal and social responsibilities of such sales; details of this training shall be recorded and made available to officers of the Responsible Authorities
- 3. An alcohol sales "Refusals Register" shall be maintained, and shall be made available to officers of the Responsible Authorities
