## 1. Proposal and Introduction

- 1.1 The Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP) is a five year health and social care plan for Devon (including Torbay and Plymouth), linked to NHS England's Five Year Forward View which aims to build and strengthen existing local relationships and focus on long term sustainable outcomes. The STP is designed to set out ways to improve citizen health and wellbeing, improve quality and deliver financial stability and balance for the local population.
- 1.2 The STP provides the framework in which to develop detailed proposals for services across Devon between now and 2020/21. A key premise throughout is to focus on promoting prevention and people's independence, and provide more effective joined up services in or closer to peoples' homes wherever possible. Seven priority areas have been identified as key programmes of work these are:
  - Prevention & early intervention
  - Integrated care model
  - Primary care
  - Mental health & learning disabilities
  - Acute hospital & specialist services
  - Productivity
  - Children & young people

- 1.3 The attached version of the STP (together with the attached briefing note) was published on 4 November 2016 and feedback from NHS England is expected. In the meantime it is being presented to all partner organisations for consideration and endorsement. Following this, there will be a process of wide stakeholder engagement involving citizens, patients, service users, their representative and voluntary sector groups to help shape these plans.
- 1.4 The Overview and Scrutiny Board will be reviewing the document as part of its statutory role to undertake health scrutiny.
