alcohol licence this all will come back which we dont want two.

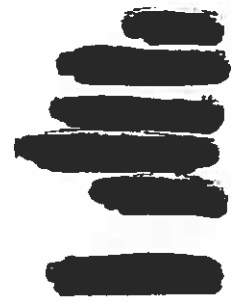
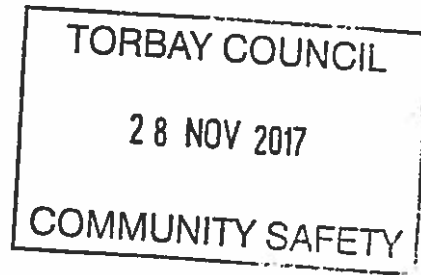
Everyone will think that the street is full of drunk people and drugs.
