7. Each FSM eligible pupil will attract £600 through the pupil premium. For pupils in maintained primary and secondary schools funding will be passed to schools via the Local Authorities. Academies will receive funding from the YPLA (EFA from April 2012). For pupils in maintained special schools and PRU's funding will be allocated to local authorities to decide whether to pass on funding to the education setting or to hold back funding to manage centrally for the benefit of those pupils it has responsibility for.
