TAKE NOTICE that I, Dave Walker Senior EHO, Torbay Council, object to the notice for a Temporary Event at The Town Hall, Castle Circus Torquay, on the grounds that allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the permissions of the notice would undermine the Licencing Objection the 'Promotion of Public Safety'

My reasons are as follows:

- There is no event management plan for the event detailing how the event will be managed and controlled, and roles and responsibilities of those involved with the event.
- 2. There are no adequate risk assessments for the event, indicating how risks to the safety of attendee's will be managed.
- 3. There is no evidence of how fire risks will be controlled, or the means attendees will be safely evacuated from the venue
- 4. There are no details or calculations relating to the provision of first aid/and or ringside medical assistance
- 5. There are no details of security provision, their duties, and qualification.
- 6. There are no adequate risk assessments for the event, indicating how risks to the safety of attendee's will be managed.

This notice is served in accordance with Section 104(2) of the Licensing Act 2003.
