### WORKINGS FOR SCHOOLS FORMULA MODELLING FOR 13/14 - NEW DELEGATION

**Notes:** Retained - Approval from Forum is required to retain centrally Infant Class Size contingency and Planned Pupil Growth funding.

De-delegation - It is for Schools Forum to decide whether the service should be retained centrally and this decision would apply to all maintained schools in each phase and the funding for these services would be removed before school budgets were issued. There can be different decisions for each phase. Academies would still receive an allocation but would be free to buy-back should they wish.

Buy-back - Funding has to be delegated within the schools budget in the first instance but schools can buy-back this service if they wish.

## DFE ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES: CONSTRUCTING THE NOTIONAL SEN BUDGET FOR A MAINSTREAM SCHOOL OR ACADEMY

#### Introduction

As at present, under the new place-plus approach to high needs funding, mainstream schools and Academies will continue to receive a clearly-identified budget for SEN. This will be their notional SEN budget.

Using their notional SEN budget, mainstream schools and Academies will be expected to:

- a. meet the needs of pupils with low-cost, high-incidence SEN; and
- b. contribute, up to a certain level set by the local authority, towards, the costs of provision for pupils with high needs (including those with high-cost, low-incidence SEN).<sup>1</sup>

In relation to the latter, under the new funding arrangements, top-up funding will be provided above this threshold on a per-pupil basis by the commissioning local authority. This is similar to the current arrangements whereby local authorities pay individually-assigned resources (IARs) to mainstream schools and Academies when placing high needs pupils in those settings.

Under the new place-plus approach, local authorities will need to decide on the level up to which mainstream schools and Academies will be expected to contribute to the costs of provision for pupils with high needs. The DfE strong recommendation is that the level of this contribution is set at £6,000 per pupil. This means that a mainstream school or Academy would be expected to contribute the first £6,000 of the additional support costs of a high needs pupil. This would be over and above the standard offer of teaching and learning provided for all pupils at the school or Academy, which would normally be funded through the school's or Academy's basic per-pupil entitlement.

As the DfE have indicated in the FAQ document, they think that most local authorities will want to use a combination of funding from the age-weighted pupil unit (AWPU), the deprivation factor, and the low-cost, high-incidence SEN (prior attainment) factor to calculate the notional SEN budget. As a reminder, the notional SEN budget is not a separate budget. It is, however, identified within a school's delegated budget, and consists of part or the whole of various formula factors as set out above. For example, the DfE would expect it to include only a small part of the basic per-pupil entitlement funding and of deprivation funding, but probably the whole of a low-cost, high-incidence SEN (prior attainment) attainment factor.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> In the March document (see paragraph 3.1.7-3.1.8), DfE defined high needs pupils and students as those requiring provision costing more than around £10,000 per year. DfE deliberately chose a financial threshold, as opposed to an assessment-based threshold – such as having a statement of SEN – since linking statutory assessments to additional funding could create perverse incentives.

#### Illustrative examples

The examples below are for a primary school of 300 pupils and a secondary school of 1000 pupils. Both schools have average percentages of Free School Meals pupils and of pupils who meet the thresholds for the low-cost, high-incidence SEN (prior attainment) factor.

The DfE believe that the average local authority's threshold for providing IARs, over and above delegated SEN funding, is already around the £6,000 that they are recommending to be used from FY2013-14. Local authorities will need to decide locally, in the light of local circumstances and discussions with schools and Academies, how big the notional SEN budget needs to be and what the balance should be within it between basic per-pupil entitlement funding, deprivation funding, and low-cost, high-incidence (prior attainment) SEN funding.

#### Torbay Examples

The Torbay illustrative examples are included at appendix 15B. These use 5% of the per pupil entitlement, 50% of the FSM/IDACI allocation and 100% of the Prior Attainment allocation to construct a notional SEN allocation. It is important to note that these calculations are not part of the schools funding formula but a method for identifying an indicative amount within the schools overall formula allocation.

#### Question 8

In the notional SEN budget calculations in appendix 15 b the proposal is for 5% of the Per pupil entitlement , 50% of FSM/IDACI funding and 100% of Prior Attainment funding to be used to calculate the notional budget. Do you agree with these proposed notional apportionments?
