16/02/10 - A drunk female was assaulted in Palace Avenue, Paignton. The three female offenders for this crime were eventually located in Paddys's Bar and all three were described as 'very drunk'. According to witnesses, there was a disturbance initially in the pub which spilled out onto the street. During the course of the assault the victim was dragged along the pavement, held down by a female whilst being kicked in the head and hit on the head with a stiletto shoe by the other female offenders.

05/06/10 - Assault on the premises whereby a male has hit another male with a pint glass causing serious injuries. Those involved were drunk. DPS and staff assisted police at the scene.

07/06/10 - Assault on the premises whereby a male received an injury to his right ear. Aggrieved would not co-operate with police or provide any statement or details of offender. CCTV of the incident was available but Mr WALSH unable to burn footage onto a disc.

11/06/10 - Male arrested for being drunk and disorderly directly outside the premises. It transpired he had been drinking in Paddy's Bar and was the subject of a Drinking Banning Order at 2 pubs in Torquay.

18/06/10 - Police called to premises regarding a male customer refusing to leave. Police attended and male removed.

13/08/10 - Police called to premises following a report of a fight inside. On arrival the offender had made off from the scene and the victim refused to co-operate with police. CCTV was checked and was found to be of poor quality and as a result vital evidence was not available. Numerous customers in the premises refused to assist police enquiries. DPS was not present at the time of this incident.

05/11/10 - Female arrested outside her home address in Queen Elizabeth Drive, Paignton, for being drunk and incapable. She was taken to Torbay Hospital for assessment and detained overnight. Female is an alcoholic and stated that she had been drinking all evening at Paddy's Bar. DPS seen following this incident and agreed she had been drinking heavily at his premises. He was warned re serving drunks.

21/11/10 - Charity box stolen from within premises. On police arrival four persons were present in the bar and all were described as 'intoxicated'. Mr WALSH arrived at the premises to operate the CCTV system and he was also described as 'heavily intoxicated'. During the course of the police investiation, difficulties were experienced by the investigating officer to access and view CCTV. CCTV was very poor quality and two offenders could clearly be seen but due to the poor quality could not be identified. Consequently this crime remains undetected. Furthermore, Mr WALSH and his staff could not download CCTV images and provide police with a copy.

23/11/10 - Aggressive, drunken male refused service of alcohol by bar staff and he then assaulted a member of staff. Police called, male arrested and charged with assault.

09/12/10 - Licensing Form L10 received from PC Le Messurier raising concerns regarding the provision of CCTV from Paddy's Bar in relation to an incident that occurred at the premises on 23/11/10 (see above). Mr Walsh was described as extremely unhelpful and showed no urgency in providing the CCTV footage. He

stated he did not know how to download from the system and did not know how to get in contact with his CCTV suppliers. CCTV was eventually provided on 16/01/11.

14/01/11 - Superintendent R BAKER wrote a letter to Mr WALSH concerning CCTV issues and Mr WALSH being drunk on his premises.

16/01/11 - Copy email received from Carrie BABBAGE (Torbay Council Licensing Officer) concerning complaints of after hours drinking, disorder, noise and public nuisance issues from a local resident.

16/01/11 - Police attended an incident at the premises at 0039 hrs, following a complaint from a resident that the DPS of Paddy's Bar was taking pictures and videoing them on his mobile phone through the premises windows. On police arrival it was established that the mobile phone did not have a camera, but Mr WALSH could not account for his actions and was clearly very intoxicated. Initially Mr WALSH refused police admittance to his premises and was very anti-police in his attitude.

24/01/11 - Meeting at Paignton Police Station between Superintendent J NYE, Mr WALSH, Neil Stanlake (Police Licensing Officer) and Julie Smart (Police Licensing Officer). Police concerns re the management of Paddy's Bar raised with Mr WALSH and he was warned that further action will be taken if the concerns were not addressed and that his premises would be closely monitored for the foreseeable future. Following the meeting a letter was sent to Mr WALSH re-iterating the matters discussed.

31/01/11 - Police attended the premises during a routine visit. DPS present but the officer formed the opinion that he was drunk and not in a fit state to run his premises.

05/02/11 - Local police officer carried out routine check of premises and noticed numerous persons smoking in the rear area of the bar. The officer did not consider that this area was compliant with the Smoke-free (Premises and Enforcement) Regulations 2006.

15/02/11 - Routine visit by police officer who spoke to the DPS and although she did not consider he was drunk, she formed the opinion that he had been drinking heavily.

23/02/11 - Neil Stanlake, Police Licensing Officer, attended premises and requested the DPS to provide a specimen copy of CCTV. DPS subsequently provided this but still the quality and images are not to evidential standard.

28/02/11 - At the request of the police a council officer attended the premises to inspect the provisions at the premises for smokers. The officer did not consider that the area designated for smokers complied with the requirements of the law.





I write to you in your capacity as Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) at the above named premises and you will recall that on the 8th July 2008, my predecessor, Superintendent Chris Singer, also wrote to you concerning issues with your ability to run the premises.

There have been a number of incidents at your premises recently, one on the 23rd November where a male assaulted a member of your staff and was subsequently arrested and is being dealt with.

During the course of police enquiries, the investigating officers have reported that they visited your premises to obtain copies of CCTV evidence and on doing so it became apparent that you were unable to download your system and provide the necessary footage.

Furthermore, my officers consider that you were not particularly co-operative and in fact they have reported that you were at the time quite drunk, which was during your permitted hours.

I am aware that Neil Stanlake, one of my Licensing Officers, has been to see you about this matter and has told me that you accepted the fact that you had been drinking and apologised if you gave the impression that you were unco-operative.

It is imperative that you understand and appreciate your responsibilities as a Designated Premises Supervisor of a licensed premise and that whenever you are present at the premises you are in full control.

In respect of your CCTV system, Neil Stanlake tells me that you admitted to him that you are unable to download any footage due to your lack of knowledge of the system. I would therefore suggest that you take immediate steps to ensure you can do so in the

future in order to be able to comply with the condition on your premises licence covering CCTV.

I am somewhat disappointed that I am having to write to you again, about you being drunk on your own premises and I am not willing to tolerate poorly licensed premises within my area.

I trust you will consider the advice that Neil Stanlake gave you and read the Constabulary's Handbook on Licensing Responsibilities that he provided you with. Should there be any further concerns or incidents at your premises where it can be proved that you and your staff were not conducting the premises in a responsible manner, I shall apply to the Local Authority Licensing Committee for a review of your Premises Licence, which could result in the loss of your livelihood.

A copy of this letter has been sent to Torbay Council Licensing Department for their information and should you require any further information, please contact Neil Stanlake at my Licensing Department on the above telephone number.

To whom it may concern,

I would like to make a complaint about the premises and landlord of Paddy's bar and restaurant on Winner street in Paignton.

I live by this pub and am always being disturbed by customers fighting, shouting or banging on the doors to be let in after he has closed up.

The landlord serves alcohol as early as 8am in the morning as people will bang on the door, he lets them in and they leave with bottles of alcohol

He also has "lock-in's" that go on til past 3am in the morning, with people banging on the doors and shouting to be let in.

When there are fights on the premises the landlord does nothing to intervene he just sits at the table and watches it all happen, sometimes even joinging in.

He lets customers shout outside whilst having cigarettes and the music is also extrememly loud, especially when the doors to the premisies are left wide open.

We have 4 young children who are always woken up by the noise and aggravation from these premises, sometimes they wake up scared aswell due to the shouting and foul language that goes with it.

We have spoken to the landlord and asked him to keep the noise down etc but this does no good as it just happens more the next evening.

He sits in the pub window drinking from sometimes 6am in the morning and this will continue throughout the day.

I hope that something can be done about this.

#### MINUTES OF MEETING

# PAIGNTON POLICE STATION -- MONDAY 24 JANUARY 2011 RE PADDY'S BAR, 107 WINNER STREET, PAIGNTON

Present:

Chief Inspector James NYE

Neil STANLAKE, Police Licensing Officer Julie SMART, Police Licensing Officer

Mr Patrick WALSH, Premises Licence Holder and DPS of Paddy's Bar

C/Insp NYE explained that Mr WALSH had been invited to attend Paignton Police Station due to growing police concerns about the way in which Paddy's Bar was being run. C/Insp NYE then ran through the details of 9 incidents that had occurred at or been linked to the premises since February 2010.

A discussion then took place regarding CCTV at the premises. Mr WALSH admitted that he cannot download footage for release to the police as he does not know how to operate the system. He was advised to seek guidance from his CCTV supplier.

A discussion followed re Mr WALSH's attitude towards the police. During an incident on 16 January 2011 Mr WALSH refused police officers entry to his premises and swore at them. Mr WALSH stated that the incident occurred after closing time and the premises were empty. C/Insp NYE stated that although this was the case, Mr WALSH should be co-operating with the police. Mr WALSH denied using abusive language to the officers.

C/Insp NYE stated that the police have evidence of the premises contributing to crime and disorder, obstruction of the police, serving drunks and several incidents of Mr WALSH being drunk on the premises. He pointed out that Mr WALSH had received two written warnings and several verbal warnings but did not appear to be taking his responsibilities seriously. Mr WALSH was informed that should there be any further incidents in relation to his premises the police would seek a Review of the Premises Licence, and police officers will be monitoring the conduct of the premises for the foreseeable future. C/Insp NYE further stated, "I expect you to be sober and helpful and you need to sort out your inability to download your CCTV". When asked if he had any questions, Mr WALSH replied, "NO, NOT REALLY".

Neil STANLAKE then raised the issue of Mr WALSH's drinking habits, and stated that it is not acceptable for a DPS to be heavily intoxicated as standards get lowered. He asked Mr WALSH, "Do you need help with your drinking?", to which Mr WALSH replied, "NO, I DON'T THINK SO. I DO HAVE A DRINK EVERYDAY I ADMIT". He also stated that he did not think there had been that many incidents at his premises.

Neil STANLAKE advised Mr WALSH to read through his Premises Licence and ensure he complies with it. Neil explained that this meeting was a last resort, and

there would be no more warnings. If any further incidents occur, the police will seek a Review. Mr WALSH was advised to contact the Licensing Department if he needs any help or advice.

C/Insp NYE summed up the main reasons for the police concerns and stated that he wished Mr WALSH to:

- 1. Sort out CCTV by mid February and contact Licensing Department when this has been done.
- 2. No further incidents to occur at the premises, but if they do Mr WALSH will cooperate with the police.
- 3. Mr WALSH not to be drunk whilst at his premises.

Neil STANLAKE then referred to an email which had been received from a local resident in which it is alleged that the premises were selling alcohol after permitted hours and that on occasions customers visit the premises at 8.00 am in the morning to purchase alcohol. Mr WALSH's response to this was "NO, NEVER".

The meeting then concluded.

In particular, I ask that you take action in respect of the below matters:

- Ensure CCTV is operating in accordance with the condition on the Premises Licence and that you are able to download and produce copies of footage on request from the police. - 2. Ensure that no further incidents occur in the premises, however should an incident occur, that you co-operate fully with my officers.


