



Thanks for your L10 concerning your recent visit to the White Hart. I found it interesting to note that stated that there is no CCTV in the premises as I went in there on 19/08/13 and spoke to a male named and female called who both explained that CCTV is in place but is to be upgraded with additional camera's being installed. Also stated that he is a partner in the business but the Designated Premises Supervisor is a male named that the lime of that visit I remember seeing at least one camera within the bar area.

Also on 26/04/13 there was an incident there. The premises were under different management at the time, but CCTV was downloaded and handed to CID.

Therefore I suggest you pay them another visit, check for camera's whilst in there and request that they give you CCTV footage within 7 days. If they are not willing to provide footage, or cannot produce the footage within that time, you could then consider seizing the hard drive/recorder. The premises does not have to have CCTV as it is not a condition on the licence (due to the hours it opens), but if they have got it and do not co-operate with you, then we can demonstrate that they are not acting responsibly and co-operating with the police, which ultimately will impact on the licensing objectives.

If we can obtain CCTV footage of someone off-loading stolen goods in there with the knowledge of staff, I will be able to take firm action in respect of this with Admiral Taverns.

Please can you keep me updated re this.

#### Mandy

There was an incident at the above premises at 1526 hrs on Tuesday 22 December 2015 whereby a male and female within the premises started arguing and the female drew other customers into the argument who then started having a go at the male. Two customers were asked to leave and became aggressive and one male went outside and had an epileptic fit (apparently he has a history of this). The barman contacted police who arrived to find one male having a fit outside and several other customers came out and were verbally abusive and aggressive to officers. One of these males was arrested. Officers describe people falling out of the premises and report that everyone inside was drunk.

When police entered there were 7-8 people inside, together with the barman. There was some confusion as to who was DPS, and I believe officers rang your department to establish who this is. One member of staff at the premises told the police that it was him and that he had Personal Licence, which he couldn't produce, and neither could he produce the Premises Licence.

About an hour after this incident, there was an incident at Ryan's Bar where a male was refused service as he was considered too drunk. This male started lashing out at customers and was restrained on the floor by and an off duty door steward. It transpired that this male was a customer at the White Hart who left on police arrival and immediately went to Ryans Bar.

I was contacted at home and gave advice to the officer who rang me to seek voluntary closure if they were concerned that there was going to be imminent disorder, before considering Section 76 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, but to ring me back if there were any further problems. I didn't hear back from the police, but I did receive a telephone call from Mr Edwin Pope of Admiral Taverns, the Premises Licence Holders, who advised me that the premises had closed at the request of the police. Mr Pope advised me that the DPS, was on holiday in Mexico and due back on 29/12/15. I advised Mr Pope that I intended to visit the premises at 11.00 am this morning to meet with staff, and Mr Pope arranged this with the staff.

I rang you this morning to see if you wanted to come, but unfortunately you were not working so I discussed with Caz but she had a lot on and your department was short staffed.

Myself and Sgt Mike Norsworthy attended the premises at 11.15 am and met with Mr and Mr and Mr They gave their account of the incident and it corroborated with what I had been advised and the detail contained with the L10. I asked what training they had been given and they said cashing up, fire safety, and who they could sell alcohol to. They both confirmed that they have received no recognised training on the Licensing Act, although Mr Said that he had been a licensee under the old Licensing Act.

Due to my concerns that Mr silver is always on holiday when I visit, I asked how often he is at the premises and they stated unless he is abroad, which he does a couple of times a year, he is nearly always there.

We discussed the importance of monitoring levels of drunkenness, the importance of contacting police at the onset of any issues (which it appears they had done on this occasion) and the need to produce the Premises Licence when requested by the police.

We also discussed the fact that the premises has a TEN for Christmas Eve until 2.00 am on Christmas Day and I pointed out that if there is excessive drunkenness and an incident at 1530 on a Tuesday afternoon, they need to be

very careful on this night. Mr told us that they have now decided they will only stay open until midnight or 12.30 am on Christmas Day.

It has since been established that both members of staff have signed a document which states they are entitled to sell authority on behalf of the DPS, but neither actually has a Personal Licence. This morning the staff were able to produce the Premises Licence, having found it located under the till drawer.

Myself and Sgt Norsworthy came away from the premises satisfied with the discussions we had and we consider that staff had dealt with this situation as best they could, but the aggravating factor is drunkenness which needs improvement.

I have submitted a Briefing Item and the premises will be monitored over the Christmas and New Year period.

I shall be arranging a meeting with the DPS, when I return to work after the New Year and will invite you to attend that.


