We are concerned about the recent violent incidents that have taken place on the premises and also the lack of conditions on the licence in relation to protection of children from harm. Therefore Children's Services would like the following specific conditions added to the licence:

- The premises shall operate a challenge 25 policy, whereby any individual who appears under the age of 25 shall be required to provide an approved form of photographic identification as outlined in Torbay Council Licensing Statement of Principles.
- Challenge 25 posters shall be displayed in the premises.
- Children under the age of 16 years will be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.
- Under 18's will not be allowed entry to the premises after 2100 hours and any under 18's will be asked to leave unless consuming a table meal.
