



Reference: Grange Court (Hoburne) Limited licence application

As our house backs directly on to Clennon Valley, we are concerned about the application for changes to the licence of the above premises for the following reasons

- NOISE:

Because of the considerable increase to the number of caravans, which we believe to be up to 500, the application to extend licencing hours to 1am for the sale of alcohol, both inside and outside, seems to us very unreasonable and unsociable as it is likely to generate a lot of noise, especially with music being played in the same areas.

- NATURE RESERVE:

The very close proximity of the nature reserve means that the extra noise will also affect the nature reserve, which is dearly appreciated by local residents.

- FLY TIPPING:

We have already noticed an increase to rubbish being thrown over the fence onto the path below, including plastic items and waste, as well as bigger items such as a foam mattress....


Already there has recently been rubbish and large items thrown over the perimeter of the camp and by the pathways.

Please advise regarding what decisions are to be made.



Although we have not made personal complainte previously to the Council we understand numerous households in our local community have in relation to previous noise (excessive) disturbances from Grange Cour.


We ome totally against any variation to the insting hience as the proplems me have experienced with unacceptable noise levels over the years is lave tood enough.



Regarding the application by Hoburne Devon Bay Holiday Park for changes to their licensing conditions at Grange Court Road, Paignton.
