I write to emphatically support the three Neighbourhood Plans prepared for Torbay bearing in mind the process which has spanned more than five years and has involved thousands of hours work beginning with thorough consultation with residents.

I support the policies within the documents which require that valuable green wedges between settlements be preserved to protect the individual identity of those settlements, working against ribbon development which will destroy the tourist industry on which the Bay survives.

I also support Policy within the plans which requires a Habitat Assessment precedes any development so that any impact on endangered wildlife can be taken into account.
