**For Order to Stop Up Highway fronting Las Iguanas, Abbey Sands,
Abbey Crescent, Torbay Road, Torquay**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Borough of Torbay, as Highway Authority, intends to apply to the Magistrates' Court sitting at Newton Abbot Magistrates' Court, The Court House, Newfoundland Way, Newton Abbot, TQ12 1LA on Monday 15 July 2019 at 2 pm for an Order ('the **Order**') under section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 to authorise the stopping up of that part of the highway fronting Las Iguanas, Abbey Sands, Abbey Crescent, Torbay Road, Torquay shown edged red on the Plan ('the **Plan**') on the ground that this part of the highway is unnecessary. The effect of the Order will be to extinguish all public rights of way over the said land.

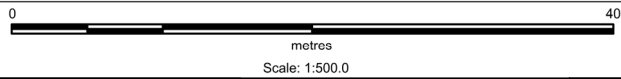
