Possible case in the setting*

Notify Torbay Council Public Health at

trackandtrace@torbay.gov.uk Include any queries or concerns that you may have about what to do.

Ensure individual isolates at home for 10 days. The rest of their household need to isolate for 14 days.

Advise that the individual gets tested via www.nhs.uk/ coronavirus or call 119.

Clean and disinfect areas the suspected case was using – ensure appropriate PPE (gloves and apron) are used.

No further action is needed until the test result is known.

Negative for COVID-19

Positive for COVID-19 follow confirmed case process

Case can return once well. Contacts can stop self-isolating and carry on as normal.

*If the **individual** has not been in the workplace during the infectious period (48 hours before symptoms to 10 days after) then no further action needs to be taken

Confirmed case in the setting member *

You may be contacted by Torbay Council Public Health or Public Health England who will provide guidance about the next steps to take.

If anyone who has been in your premises informs you they have received a positive test result, immediately contact **Torbay Council Public Health** on **01803 208030** and at trackandtrace@torbay.gov.uk

PHE can also be contacted on 0300 303 8162 (24/7)

Ensure individual isolates at home for 10 days. The rest of their household need to isolate for 14 days.

Anyone who has had **close contact**** with the positive case should be identified, sent home and advised to self-isolate for 14 days. The household of these contacts do not need to isolate.

If they, or their household subsequently develop symptoms they need to get tested via 119 or www.nhs.uk/coronavirus

Clean and disinfect areas the confirmed case and close contacts were using – ensure appropriate PPE (minimum gloves and apron) are used.

Cases & contacts can return once the isolation period is completed and they are well.

2 or more confirmed cases in the same setting *

You will be contacted by Torbay Council Public Health Team or PHE with guidance about the steps you need to take. If you have not been contacted please contact Torbay Council Public Health on 01803 208030 and at trackandtrace@torbay.gov.uk. PHE can also be contacted on 0300 303 8162 (24/7)

Ensure confirmed positive cases isolate for 10 days. The rest of their households need to isolate for 14 days.

Anyone who has been in **close contact**** with the confirmed positive cases should be identified, sent home and advised to self-isolate for 14 days. The households of these individuals do not need to isolate.

Advise that anyone with symptoms get tested via www.nhs.uk/coronavirus or call 119.

Clean and disinfect areas the positive cases were using – ensure appropriate PPE (minimum gloves and apron) are used.

Torbay Council Public Health or PHE will provide support with communications and infection control advice. Use the contact details above if:

- The situation worsens considerably
- There are any hospitalisations
- There is any media interest or you have any concerns
