Key messages on Tier 2 restrictions for businesses and events



#### **Across all tiers**

- All businesses and venues are required to follow Covid-19 secure guidelines
- These businesses can remain open:
  - Essential and non-essential retail
  - Personal care and close contact services
  - Public buildings, eg. libraries
  - · Allotments, waste centres, public toilets
  - Essential public services eg. NHS
  - Places of worship

# What about restaurants and pubs?

- Last orders 10pm, closed 11pm-5am
- Alcohol served only with a substantial meal
- Individuals can only meet indoors with their own household or support bubble (max 6 people)
  - Bookings must be from one household or support bubble
  - Businesses must stop households mingling indoors
- Table service only

#### What about hairdressers?

- Increased frequency of handwashing and surface cleaning
- 2m social distancing- or 1 metre with risk mitigation
  - More handwashing
  - Keep activity short
  - Working from back or side of client
  - Screens or barriers
  - Avoid skin to skin contact
  - Pair staff

#### What about events and theatre?

- The lower of:
  - 50% capacity
  - 1000 indoors
  - 2000 outdoors
- Wedding limit of 20
- Funeral limit of 30
- Theatres to close by 11pm

## What about sports?

- Outdoor sport, physical activity and exercise classes can continue
- Indoor sport can continue if it is possible to avoid people mixing outside their household / bubble
- Exceptions for:
  - Disability sport
  - · Sport for educational purpose
  - Under 18s


# **Christmas guidance**



- 23<sup>rd</sup> -27<sup>th</sup> December you may form a Christmas Bubble of up to three households
- The rules on the following will not change:
  - who you can meet in pubs and restaurants
  - Who you can attend indoor events with
  - · Weddings and funerals
- You may attend a place of worship with your Christmas Bubble
- You may carol sing (guidance on safer singing)
- You may attend school plays, with safeguards

#### **Points from the Chat**
