- These three households must remain the same throughout the day
- Think carefully about the risk to you and your loved ones before forming a Christmas bubble
- You cannot meet anyone from a Tier 4 area

Christmas Bubbles



- Only meet your Christmas bubble in private homes or in your garden, places of worship, or public outdoor spaces
- Stay local and avoid travel
- Ideally, stop all contact outside your immediate household 5 days pre Christmas

Top tips this Christmas

- Small, local and short
- Outside wherever possible
- If inside
 - Ventilate
 - Physical distancing
 - Face coverings
 - Wash hands regularly
- Virtual meet ups with wider family

Restaurants and pubs?

- The rules on who you can meet in bars, pubs and restaurants will not change
 - You may only eat out with your household or support bubble
- You must not have a work Christmas lunch or party as a social activity

Places of Worship

- You may attend places of worship in Tier 2
- On 25th December you may attend a place of worship with your Christmas bubble
- There is further information in the <u>guidance for the safe use</u> of places of worship during the pandemic.

Care Homes

 You should not visit friends and family in care homes at Christmas if you have any symptoms or have been in contact with anyone who has

Shops

- Santa's grotto may be open in all tiers these should be made COVID-19 secure
- Shops may open, but you should only go with people from your household or support bubble.



COVID Community Champions



Travel at Christmas

- You may travel for your Christmas Bubble
 - Plan ahead
 - Avoid unnecessary stops
 - · Wear a face covering, sanitise and keep distance
 - Don't car share outside of household / support bubble
- If necessary, you can stay in a hotel, hostel or B&B during the Christmas period outside of a Tier 4 area
- Stay local if possible

From the 26th

- Rules as per Tier 2
- This means you can only meet your support bubble indoors
- There are NO exceptions for new year



COVID-19 testing this Christmas

- If you test positive for COVID-19 over Christmas, you must self-isolate
- If you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive, you must self-isolate for 10 days even over Christmas
- If you have been in contact with a positive case, you must self-isolate even if you subsequently test negative

New Variant

- Potentially more infectious
- Does not appear to be more serious at the moment
- · Can be tested for using existing tests
- Vaccine should still be effective
