The results – Nature-based solutions

Key priority to tackle

 Flooding, loss of habitat, carbon capture from trees and plants and sea grasses.

What is needed to accelerate action?

- Nature needs to be integrated and protected
- Wildlife corridors, no mow verges, plant more trees
- Sea grass projects and projects to improve fishing practices that are less damaging
- Regenerative farming
- Building nature into new developments
- Business support programme





The results – Transport

Key priority to tackle

 Electric vehicles and charging facilities, car share, safety of our roads for walking and cycling and free bus services

What is needed to accelerate action?

- Improved bus network (including for schools) and electric buses
- Improved cycling infrastructure and facilities
- Develop car share schemes
- Commuter boats





The results – Decarbonising Homes

Key priority to tackle

 Electric vehicles and charging facilities, car share, safety of our roads for walking and cycling and free bus services

What is needed to accelerate action?

- Improve sustainable design in the planning system and 20 mins neighbourhoods
- Facilitate whole street energy efficiency programmes and partner with companies to bulk buy
- Make the social housing stock more sustainable and free audits and quick wins
- Information for businesses and landlords
- Council Tax used to improve sustainability of homes and buildings
- Create a retrofit hub one stop shop
