

ORDER**BOROUGH OF TORBAY****(A3022 BRIXHAM/DARTMOUTH ROAD AND A379 DARTMOUTH ROAD, CHURSTON)
(CONSOLIDATION) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2008**

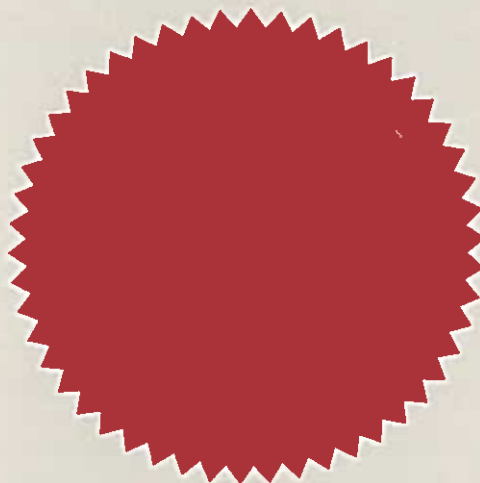

Torbay Council and Devon County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84(1)(a) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on the length of roads specified in Schedule I to this Order.
2. This Order shall come into force on 9 May 2008 and be cited as "the Borough of Torbay A3022 Brixham/Dartmouth Road and A379 Dartmouth Road, Churston (Consolidation) (40 mph Speed Limit Restriction) Order 2008.
3. The Orders or parts thereof specified in Schedule I are hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE I

REVOCATIONS

The County of Devon (A3022 Brixham Road, Churston/Brixham) (40 mph speed restriction) Order 2002.

Part

1. That length of Brixham Road (A3022) which extends from a point 40 metres south east of its junction with the A379 (Dartmouth turn-off near Prouts Garage) to a point 91 metres west of its junction with Monksbridge Road, Brixham (a distance of approximately 1855 metres).
2. That length of Dartmouth Road, Churston (A3022) which extends from a point 44 metres south of its southern junction from Bascombe Road to a point 40 metres south of its junction with A379 (near Prouts Garage).
3. That length of Brixham Road, Churston (A3022) from its junction with the A379 (near Prouts Garage) south-eastwards for a distance of 40 metres.

SCHEDULE II

40 MPH SPEED LIMIT RESTRICTIONS

1. A3022 Dartmouth Road/Brixham Road

That length of the A3022 known as Dartmouth Road, Churston which extends in a southerly direction from a point 166 metres south of its junction with Langdon Lane, Galmpton to a point 40 metres south-east of its junction with the A379 (which proceeds in a south-westerly direction towards Kingswear and is known as Dartmouth Road) at the said junction the A3022 becomes known as Brixham Road.

2. A3022 Brixham Road

That length of the A3022 Brixham Road which extends from a point 40 metres south-east of its junction with Dartmouth Road (A379) a distance of 1929 metres in a south-easterly direction to a point 84 metres west of its junction with Monksbridge Road, Brixham.

3. A379 Dartmouth Road

That length of the A379 Dartmouth Road (to Kingswear) extending south-westerly from the centre of its junction with the A3022 Brixham Road to a point 40 metres south-west thereof.
