Introduction

In 2013 Torbay Youth Service began to capture the views of 8 to 25 year olds on how the Service could develop a full Youth Offer in Torbay, including a range of support, advice and guidance opportunities. The results of this consultation were collated and can be found at:

In 2014 the survey was reviewed and once again a consultation took place in order to gather further feedback from children and young people on how the Youth Offer in Torbay was meeting their needs and requirements. This is in terms of what they perceive quality Youth Services and activities to be within the 3 towns of Torquay, Paignton and Brixham.

The Survey also wanted to capture young people's experiences across Torbay as to whether they were accessing the My Place Youth Hub at Parkfield Youth Centre in Paignton. There were two specific questions on Parkfield, which was intentional due to the proposed changes in how the centre is staffed with partners and the way that services will be delivered in the future. This is therefore with regards to the move towards a Youth Trust model of delivery in Torbay in continued partnership with the community and voluntary sector.

Methodology

Torbay Youth Service designed, produced and distributed paper questionnaires to a variety of youth service providers asking them to circulate copies amongst the young people who attend their provision.

An online version of this survey was produced by the Performance, Policy and Review Team. This was also circulated by Torbay Youth Service.

Tables were constructed and percentages calculated using the overall number of questionnaires received (145) as the denominator unless otherwise stated.

Quality Assurance

To ensure the quality of data provided, all information received through both the online and paper surveys were verified and moderated. This provides reassurance that the results presented overleaf are a true representation of respondent's views.

Summary of results in comparison to last year's Survey

It is not possible to know how many of the same or different young people took part in the survey last year and again this year. However it is useful to make some comparisons to last year's results.

- 63.4% of the young people have youth groups or activities in their area, compared to 74.8% last year.
- 53.1 % attend a youth group or activity at least once a week compared to 53% last year.
- The most common opportunities offered are still making friends, a safe and enjoyable place to go and someone to talk to.

- The least common opportunities are still spiritual development and accreditations or youth awards.
- 53.1% of the young people heard about the club / activity they attend from friends compared with 49% last year.
- Friends and Facebook are still the preferred method of communications.
- Most of the respondents (49.7%) walked to the group / activity, which is exactly the same percentage as last year.
- 37.2% of the young people think that the range of activities and facilities in Torbay is very good compared to 40.6% last year.
- Bullying was still the most likely reason people would stop attending a provision.
- Despite ongoing encouragement, there were less neighbourhood responses this year from partner groups due to services having increased commitments and reduced capacity, especially over the summer period. The feedback also contained a disproportionate response from Paignton and there is the likelihood that more of these respondents were users of Parkfield than last year.

In Conclusion

Although this survey only provides a snap shot of young people's opinions about the universal provision for young people in Torbay, it provides some interesting comments.

The tables, including in the Appendix, make interesting reading because they list the subjective comments that young people have made about a range of provision across Torbay. It is clear that on the whole young people want places to go that have friendly staff, where they can take part in a range of activities and where they can meet their friends or make new ones. "The People" appears

to be the most fundamental component of a youth provision – be it existing friends, youth workers or meeting new people.

Bullying is still listed as one of the biggest reasons for not attending youth provision and this reinforces that Torbay's Community Youth Services need to keep this on the agenda and to continue to challenge to all forms of bullying. Training for staff and volunteers in this area will continue to be needed and updated as online bullying becomes more common.

There have been some references to inevitable resource issues and around sufficiency of services and opening times, but despite changes nationally in budgets this survey has not uncovered any huge gaps in provision. The Youth Activities Grant has funded numerous projects over the last 3 years and some key partnerships have come out of this within each of the 3 towns. One area has been flagged however is the lack of inclusive provision for young people with disabilities. Although there are 3 provisions within the Community Youth Services Directory for young people with disabilities and their non-disabled peers, we do need to consider what more the mainstream groups can be doing to ensure young people with disabilities want to access their services. References to having safe places to go as well as having somewhere to escape to and away from family issues or responsibilities are mentioned as well on several occasions. The basic premise of youth provisions offering warm, safe spaces appears not to have wavered, even with changes in technology and the pace of life in our communities. This survey indicates to a large degree that a place of belonging, with a sense of community is still very important for young people.

The results of this survey will be added to other consultation work with young people and will feed into the Youth Offer review that will take place prior to early 2015.
