



Proposed outside cafe licensed area, 9.5m long & 2.1m wide. Formed with socketed, lockable & removable bollards installed to segregate the live highway from the licensed cafe area. Types of bollards to be 'Manchester' type, removable and socketed (From Broxap, or similar approved product). To include reflective banding.

Example picture of Manchester bollard



Existing bollards originally installed to form a splayed edge for the two existing areas to be re-positioned as demarcation between the three licensed areas. As shown with arrows. With approval from Torbay Council licencing and existing cafe owners to ensure no conflict with existing licences.
